

Seasonal Campers – Mariners Point RV Campground 2022

For your comfort and safety, the following rules have been established. We reserve the right to enforce all rules to ensure guests the maximum enjoyment from the park's many facilities.

Dates of Operation

- The 2022 season opens Friday, May 6th and closes at noon Sunday, October 23rd.

Visitors

- Visitors are welcome between the hours of 10 AM to 9 PM. A visitor fee of \$5 is applicable on entry.
- All visitors must be signed-in at the Welcome Centre by the camper where they are visiting. Sites are limited to a maximum total of 10 people including the campers. All visitors must park in the visitor parking at the Welcome Centre.

Quiet Time

- Between 11 PM to 8 AM
- Zero tolerance for noise during quiet time, our policy is to provide one warning, and then the guests are asked to leave.
- Do not disturb the sleeping neighbours.
- Excessive noise, loud music, foul language and unruly or disruptive behavior will not be permitted at any time of the day.

Alcohol and drugs

- Alcohol may be consumed responsibly within the park. Please be considerate of your neighbours.
- The use of any non-prescription drugs including cannabis is strictly prohibited and will be grounds for immediate expulsion from the park without refund.

General Information

- Restrooms and showers are open around the clock. Please close doors when exiting the facilities to keep the bugs out.
- Laundry facilities are available. Please pay at the office.
CLOTHESLINES ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- Generators may only be used during non-quiet times (8 AM to 11 PM).
- Fires are allowed in fire rings only. DO NOT move fire rings without approval from the office.
- All garbage and recycling must be deposited in the bins provided so as not to attract wildlife or other rodents.

- Garbage and recycling must be stored in a secured area or inside the RV (not in tents) until disposal.

Use of site

- Please ensure that your grey and black water tanks are always closed.
- The maximum number of people per registered site is 2 adults and 4 children to a maximum 6 people.
- Additional visitors over the age of 18 will be charged \$5 per night or \$27 per night if they are in a tent on your site.
- Space permitting, each site may be used for the parking of one RV, one tow vehicle and a second vehicle if needed. All other vehicles and visitors shall park in areas designated by the staff and may be subject to additional parking charges.

Campfires

- Are permitted at each campsite in the rings provided
- Must always be attended.
- Do not burn garbage.
- Fire rings are not to be relocated within the site nor removed from the site.
- Do not remove bark, cut or damage trees in the campground.
- Wood is available at the office for purchase.

Fireworks

Fireworks are restricted to the field above the beach and not from your site. Please ensure you clean up the remnants of the fireworks.

Vehicle Restrictions

- Watch for children playing.
- Park only in designated parking areas and please do not block roads.
- Speed limit in the campground is 10 KM per hour.
- Unlicensed vehicles (trail bikes, quads, off-road or any other motorized vehicles) are not allowed to operate in the park. Low speed golf carts is the exception.

Adult Supervision

We ask that children use the playground or common areas for sports or games, as safety is our priority, as well as respecting our campers' privacy.

Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children, regardless of age. Children under the age of 12 years must always be supervised while swimming by a responsible adult. This does not mean older children.

Pets

- Must be under control.

- On a leash always.
- Waste must be picked up and deposited in the garbage bin.
- Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
- Vicious dogs will not be allowed.
- Must not be left unattended.

Privacy

Please respect the privacy of other guests. Do not walk-through occupied sites.

Seasonal Sites

Seasonal sites are for the exclusive use of the renter and the registered renter is subject to the following:

- Seasonal fees are payable by cash, cheque, or e-transfer.
- Fees must be paid in full at the start of the season.
- Use of your site by unregistered guests is NOT PERMITTED unless the registered camper is present. We cannot be responsible for your RV or the people in it.
- At no time will persons 19 years of age or under be allowed to overnight on a seasonal site unless the person who paid for the site is present.
- The registered site owner is the person named on the registration you completed when your site was chosen. All guests are subject to a \$5.00 minimum additional fee if they are on your site past 9 PM.
- Use of any external electrical power, (recharging golf carts, outside refrigerators/ freezers, etc.) are subject to a monthly fee over and above your seasonal rate.
- Decks not higher than the level of the lowest floor of your RV are permitted in the area between lots. Any screened tent or enclosed building must be placed in the area behind your RV where it does not interfere with the view of campers in the lots behind you.
- Care of your lot is your responsibility. A lawnmower and weed cutter are available for your use at the Welcome Centre. It is up to the camper to keep their site neat and tidy, that includes near, and under your RV.
- Boats or any other object tied to the boat docks are subject to docking fees as listed on website.

Mariners Point RV Campground is privately owned and reserves the right to terminate any site rental for violation of our policies without refund. The camper assumes full responsibility for injury or illness occurring to them or members of their family, or visitors. Additionally, we assume no responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen property occurring to anyone while on our grounds or in our facilities.
