



Park Rules

For your comfort and safety, the following rules have been established. We reserve the right to enforce all rules to ensure guests the maximum enjoyment from the park's many facilities.

Check-in/Check-out Procedures

RV Sites: Check In - 2 PM Check Out - 12 PM (noon)

1. All campers must register at the office upon arrival. If you wish to extend your stay the office must be notified by 11 AM.
2. Visitors are welcome between the hours of 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM. A fee of \$5.00 is applicable for visitors remaining in the park after 9:00 PM. All visitors must be signed-in at the Welcome Centre by the camper where they are visiting. Sites are limited to a maximum total of 10 people including the campers. All visitors must park in the visitor parking at the Welcome Centre.
3. Anyone visiting on special event days will be required to pay a fee determined for that event.
4. If you arrive at the campground with more people or vehicles than you have reserved, there will be additional nightly campsite fees, or accommodation may not be available.
5. Quiet time is 11 PM until 8 AM. ZERO tolerance for noise during quiet time, our policy is to provide one warning, and then the guests are asked to leave.
6. All vehicles must respect the 10 km per hour speed limit in the campground.
7. Unlicensed vehicles (trail bikes, quads, off-road or any other motorized vehicles) are not allowed to operate in the park. Low speed golf carts is the exception.
8. Alcohol may be consumed responsibly within the park. Please be considerate of your neighbours.
9. The use of any non-prescription drugs including cannabis are strictly prohibited and will be grounds for immediate expulsion from the park without refund.
10. We ask that children use the playground or common areas for sports or games, as safety is our priority, as well as respecting our campers' privacy.

11. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children, regardless of age. Children under the age of 12 years must always be supervised while swimming by a responsible adult. This does not mean older children.
12. Dogs must always be kept on a leash. Please pick-up doggie doo!! No pets are to be left outside unattended. Barking should be kept at a minimal.
13. Fires are allowed in fire rings only. DO NOT move fire rings without approval from the office.
14. Cutting trees is prohibited. There is wood available at the office for purchase.
15. When you are away from your site for an extended period (4 hours or more), please ensure all air conditioners and lights are turned off.
16. All garbage and recycling must be deposited in the bins provided so as not to attract wildlife. They must be stored inside the RV (not in tents) until disposed.

Amenities

1. Firewood and ice are available for purchase at the office
2. Restrooms are open around the clock. Please close doors when exiting the facilities to keep the bugs out. Our showers are not open currently due to Covid-19.
3. Laundry facilities are available. Please pay at the office. CLOTHESLINES ARE NOT PERMITTED.
4. Unsupervised beach
5. Kayaks rentals are available at the office.
6. A dumping station is available in the campground.
7. The municipality of Nackawic has a grocery store with liquor store, a Dollar Store, and more in their plaza within 3 minutes of the park.
